It didn't work because they set off too early and their supplies got ruined on the Tiger ship. It also failed because lots of Native American's didn't like the English because they were continuously asking for food. In addition to this, they did not have enough people to make it work successfully, Raleigh wanted 300 men, however, he only got 107. Furthermore, most of the people that went were not experienced enough to create a new colony.

One reason why Elizabethan's failed to colonise Virginia was because of the resistance from the Native Americans. For example, tension grew when the English became more reliant on the Native American's for food handouts. This meant the attempt to colonise failed as the English expectations of how the Indians should treat them eventually led to a planned attack, led by Chief Wingina, however this was prevented as Ralph Lane killed Wingina before he could carry out the plan. This meant the English could no longer rely on them for food as their relationship had been destroyed, as the English had no supplies of their own due to the late arrival. This meant they had to leave the island as a means of survival.

One reason why the attempt the colonise Virginia failed was due to the lack of cooperation between the settlers. For example, many people joined the journey in the hope of becoming rich quickly, the merchants and gentlemen were not willing to do any physical work, whilst the farmers were not prepared to do all of the work for the upper class. This led to failure as the lack of communication meant that there could be no clear leader or hierarchy like they were used to at home.
